

## *PA- Supplemental Guidance*

**SOE-03**     **Continuous No-Till (Organic System)** – Requires use of CONTINUOUS no-till for life of contract. Low residue crops must be followed by a cover crop. Crops will be terminated by non herbicidal, non tillage methods. Soil loss, over the length of the rotation, may not exceed T (tolerable soil loss level).

Agricultural operations must be Certified Organic through the USDA National Organic Program or in the transition to organic process.
