Instructions to Access County Data
(Updated September 2009)

Go to <http://www.cr.nps.gov/NR/>

Or go directly to <http://www.nr.nps.gov/> and proceed to third bullet below.

- Left bar, click 'Database/Research'
- Halfway down page under Research our Collection, second bullet, click <http://www.nr.nps.gov/> for old 'NRIS Database'
- Click 'Location'
- Click 'State and County'
- Enter 1) PA 2) your county
- Execute

To Print:

- Try to right click on the data
- Click 'Print'
- If there are multiple pages, you will likely need to repeat the Print process for each page

To save a copy:

- Bottom of screen, click 'Export'
- *Type:* 'Microsoft Excel'
- *Format:* check 'include title', 'include row number'
- *Rows:* check 'all'
- Click 'Export'
- Save file wherever you want to store it.
- You can adjust column widths or wrap text to fit on 8.5x11 or 8.5x14 format

Be sure to check this site for updates once or twice a year.
